Entry Fee: \$65 per Player

ELIGIBILITY: The Championships are open to amateur players who are members of a men's club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association (MPGA) and carry an active GHIN handicap. In order to play in the Mid-Amateur (only), a player must be at least 30 years of age as of May 15, 2010.

FORMAT: The **Individual Low Net Championship** is a two-day, 36-hole event. This event will have divisions based on the number of entries and handicaps. Full handicaps will be applied after adjusting to the slope rating of the golf course. Your handicap index as of entry closing date will be used and will determine in which division you will be placed. If a tie occurs for first place, a sudden death playoff (all Divisions) will take place. The Committee may adjust handicaps in accordance with USGA approved procedures. (See Knuth Points definition on www.mpga.net)

MID-AM: The **State Mid-Amateur Championship** is a two-day, 36-hole event. This event will be one division stroke play (no handicap). If a tie occurs for first place, a sudden death playoff will take place.

COMPETITION: Each entrant must select one Championship in which to participate. If no selection is made on the application form, he will be placed in the Individual Low Net Championship.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES: Entries must be received at the MPGA Post Office Box not later than May 1, 2010. Accepted entries will be posted on our website www.mpga.net.

ENTRY WITHDRAWAL AND REFUNDS: Entry fee will be refunded if the MPGA is notified before the close of entries. Fees will not be refunded after close of entry.

RULES: USGA rules govern all play except as amended by the Committee. Rangefinders may be used for distance measurements only. The MPGA Code of Conduct policy and dress code is in effect (reference www.mpga.net).

STARTING TIME: Pairing/starting times will be **e-mailed** to each entrant prior to the tournament with his starting time. Starting times will be posted on the web site. Please report to the registration table at least 20 minutes prior to your starting time and to your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time, ready to play. Rule 6-3a (note) is in effect.

POWER CART RENTAL: Power carts are allowed, please pay for their use in Pro Shop. To reserve a cart call Emerald Greens at (651) 480-8558.

MGA PLAYER POINTS: (Mid-Amateur only) – 1st - 50, 2nd - 40, 3rd - 30, 4th - 20, 5th - 15, 6th - 10, 7th - 5 points.
